See how these specially trained medieval men and women would undertake anything from a haircut and shave to an amputation or arrow removal, in a world where germs were not known about. Subjects included are: shaving, amputations, the four humors, bleeding, herb lore, teeth and dentistry, men and women practitioners, treatment of wounds, arrow extraction and stitching, the role of physicians and dealing with common illnesses. Handle objects and smell some smelly smells. This session complements 'Medieval Medicine'.

National Curriculum:

- Events beyond living memory that are significant nationally or globally and lives of significant individuals
- A local history study (a study of an aspect of history or a site dating from a period beyond 1066) and Extending pupils chronological knowledge beyond 1066 (the changing of monarchs)
- The development of church, state and society in medieval Britain 1066-1509
- The Wars of the Roses (1450-1471)
- Listen and respond appropriately to adults and their peers, ask relevant questions to extend their understanding and knowledge and articulate and justify answers, arguments and opinions

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
