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Summary:

King Richard III is preparing to go into battle against Henry Tudor. He's quite concerned that he won't have enough good knights to fight for him. He has even been told that some of his best knights have run away to join Thomas Stanley and it's anyone's guess whose side they'll be on! Learn about symbols and meanings in heraldry and help King Richard choose his knights at the battle of Bosworth.
