



Welcome to Bosworth Battlefield, drive up this lane to reach the car park



There are 5 disabled car parking spaces. Please pay for your parking at the machine.
You can enter the site on foot by following the entrance arrows.



You can also access the site from the upper courtyard. The terrain is smooth and on a slope.



To enter the exhibition, you must go through the Ticket Office.
There is a charge for entry.



You will be greeted by our friendly staff who will give you information about the site.
You can collect ear protectors here.



You will be able to see, hear and touch lots of things in the exhibition.



Throughout the exhibition you can press buttons to listen to information as well as touch interactive displays.

The Sundial walk is 570 metre circular walk on uneven terrain. It is peaceful here, with seating for reflection. The Sundial area is gated.
